Project Overview

Spartanburg Academic Movement has been awarded a 2023 Full-Service Community Schools Grant to implement initiatives aimed at enhancing the educational experience, fostering community partnerships, and improving outcomes for students in Spartanburg. The grant encompasses various programs and activities designed to create a holistic and supportive learning environment.

Scope of Work

The selected evaluator will be responsible for conducting a comprehensive evaluation of the Full-Service Community Schools Grant. Key responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- 3. Strong communication skills, including the ability to present findings in a clear and accessible manner.

Proposal Submission

Interested evaluators are invited to submit a detailed proposal outlining their approach to evaluating the Full-Service Community Schools Grant. Proposals should include the following:

- 1. Overview of relevant experience and qualifications.
- 2. Proposed methodology and timeline for the evaluation.
- 3. Detailed budget, including all anticipated expenses.
- 4. Two professional references.
